Eeyore might seem to have a gray cloud hanging over his head, but he never fails to cheer up his friends when they need it.

This pattern has a removable tail, but for little ones, I recommend connecting the tail with a small piece of yarn so Eeyore won't lose it.

WORSTED WEIGHT YARN IN DARK GRAY, LIGHT GRAY, LAVENDER, MAGENTA, AND BLACK

G/6 (4 MM) CROCHET HOOK

TAPESTRY NEEDLE

BLACK, MEDIUM GRAY, WHITE, AND GRAYISH-BLUE FELT

FABRIC GLUE OR SEWING NEEDLE AND THREAD

STUFFING

MARKING PINS

SCISSORS

¼ IN. METAL SEW-ON SNAP

OPTIONAL: ROW COUNTER, SPLIT/LOCKING RINGS

FINISHED SIZE: About 7" long.

Instructions

HEAD

- In dark gray, sc 8 in an adjustable ring.
- Rnd 1:** sc 2 in each sc around. (16 sts)
- Rnd 2:** *sc 3, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 3 more times. (20 sts)
- Rnds 3–5:** sc 20.
- Rnd 6:** *sc 3, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (16 sts)
- Rnd 7:** *sc 2, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (12 sts)
- Rnd 8:** *sc 2, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 3 more times. (16 sts)
- Rnd 9:** sc 16.
- Change to light gray for the muzzle.
- Rnd 10:** *sc 7, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 1 more time. (18 sts)
- Rnd 11:** *sc 5, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 2 more times. (21 sts)
- Rnds 12–13:** sc 21.
- Rnd 14:** *sc 6, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 2 more times. (24 sts)
- Rnd 15:** sc2tog 12 times. (12 sts)
- Stuff head.
- Rnd 16:** sc2tog 6 times. (6 sts)
- Fasten off yarn and close up hole.

LOWER LIP

- In light gray, sc 6 in an adjustable ring. Do not join first st to last st. Ch 1 and turn.
- Row 1:** sk first ch, sc 2 in each st, ch 1 and turn. (12 sts)
- Row 2:** sk first ch, sl st 12. (12 sts)
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

OUTER EARS (MAKE TWO)

- In dark gray, loosely ch 7.
- Rnd 1:** starting in second ch from hook and working in back ridge loops, sc 5,

sc 3 in next st. Rotate chain so front loops are facing up. Starting in next st and working in front loops, sc 4, sc 2 in next st. (14 sts)

Rnd 2: sl st 2, sc 3, sc 2 in next st, hdc 2 in next st, sc 2 in next st, sc 3, sl st 2, (hdc 1, dc 1, hdc 1) in next st. (19 sts)

Rnd 3: sl st 2, sc 5, hdc 2, sc 5, sl st 3, (sc 1, hdc 1, sc 1) in next st, sl st 1. (21 sts)

- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

INNER EARS (MAKE TWO)

- In lavender, loosely ch 7.
- Rnd 1:** starting in second ch from hook and working in back ridge loops, sc 5, sc 3 in next st. Rotate chain so front loops are facing up. Starting in next st and working in front loops, sc 4, sc 2 in next st. (14 sts)
- Rnd 2:** sl st 2, sc 3, sc 2 in next st, hdc 2 in next st, sc 2 in next st, sc 3, sl st 2, (hdc 1, dc 1, hdc 1) in next st. (19 sts)
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

SIDES (MAKE TWO)

- In dark gray, loosely ch 17.
- Row 1:** sk first ch, sc 2 in next st, sc 14, sc 2 in next st, ch 1 and turn. (18 sts)
- Row 2:** sk first ch, sc 2 in next st, sc 17, ch 1 and turn. (19 sts)
- Row 3:** sk first ch, sc 18, sc 3 in next st, ch 1 and turn. (21 sts)
- Row 4:** sk first ch, sc 20, sc 2 in next st, ch 1 and turn. (22 sts)
- Row 5:** sk first ch, sc 20, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (21 sts)
- Row 6:** sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 19, ch 1 and turn. (20 sts)
- Row 7:** sk first ch, sc 18, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (19 sts)

Row 8: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 15, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (17 sts)

Row 9: sk first ch, sc 14, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (15 sts)

Row 10: sk first ch, sc 1, pm, sc 14, ch 1 and turn. (15 sts)

- Start back leg.

Row 11a: sk first ch, sc 7, ch 1 and turn. (7 sts)

Row 12a: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 5, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 13a: sk first ch, sc 4, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (5 sts)

Row 14a: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 3, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Rows 15a-16a: sk first ch, sc 4, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Row 17a: sk first ch, sc 2, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (3 sts)

Row 18a: sk first ch, sk 1, sc2tog. (1 st)

- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

- Start front leg.

Row 11b: to rejoin dark gray, (sl st 1, ch 1, sc 1) in pm st, sc 6, ch 1 and turn. Remove marker. (7 sts)

Row 12b: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 5, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 13b: sk first ch, sc 4, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (5 sts)

Row 14b: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 3, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Rows 15b-16b: sk first ch, sc 4, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Row 17b: sk first ch, sc 2, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (3 sts)

Row 18b: sk first ch, sk 1, sc2tog. (1 st)

- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

BELLY

- In dark gray, loosely ch 4.

Row 1: starting in second ch from hook, sc 3, ch 1 and turn. (3 sts)

Row 2: sk first ch, sc 1, sc 2 in next st, sc 1, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Row 3: sk first ch, sc 1, sc 2 in next 2 sts, sc 1. *Change to light gray.* Ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 4: sk first ch, sc 6, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 5: sk first ch, sc 6, ch 1 and turn. Pm on edges at beginning and end of this row. (6 sts)

Rows 6-8: sk first ch, sc 6, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 9: sk first ch, sc 2, sc 2 in next 2 sts, sc 2, ch 1 and turn. (8 sts)

Row 10: sk first ch, sc 8, ch 1 and turn. (8 sts)

Row 11: sk first ch, sc 8, ch 1 and turn. Pm on edges at beginning and end of this row. (8 sts)

Rows 12-13: sk first ch, sc 8, ch 1 and turn. (8 sts)

Row 14: sk first ch, sc 8, ch 1 and turn. Pm on edges at beginning and end of this row. (8 sts)

Row 15: sk first ch, sc 8, ch 1 and turn. (8 sts)

Row 16: sk first ch, sc 2, sc2tog 2 times, sc 2, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Rows 17-19: sk first ch, sc 6, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 20: sk first ch, sc 6, ch 1 and turn. Pm on edges at beginning and end of this row. (6 sts)

Rows 21-22: sk first ch, sc 6, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 23: sk first ch, sc2tog 3 times, ch 1 and turn. (3 sts)

- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

- Before beginning legs, select a side of your belly piece to be the RS and secure a pm to it.

LEFT FRONT LEG

Row 1: with RS of belly facing up, work along edge from row 11 pm toward row 5 pm. To rejoin light gray, (sl st 1, ch 1, sc 1) in row 11 pm st, sc 6 to row 5 pm st, ch 1 and turn. Remove markers. (7 sts)

Row 2: sk first ch, sc 5, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 3: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 4, ch 1 and turn. (5 sts)

Row 4: sk first ch, sc 3, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Rows 5-6: sk first ch, sc 4, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Row 7: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 2, ch 1 and turn. (3 sts)

Row 8: sk first ch, sc2tog, sl st 1, and fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT LEG

Row 1: with WS facing up, work along edge from row 11 pm toward row 5 pm. To rejoin light gray, (sl st 1, ch 1, sc 1) in row 11 pm st, sc 6 to row 5 pm st, ch 1 and turn. Remove markers. (7 sts)

Row 2: sk first ch, sc 5, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 3: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 4, ch 1 and turn. (5 sts)

Row 4: sk first ch, sc 3, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

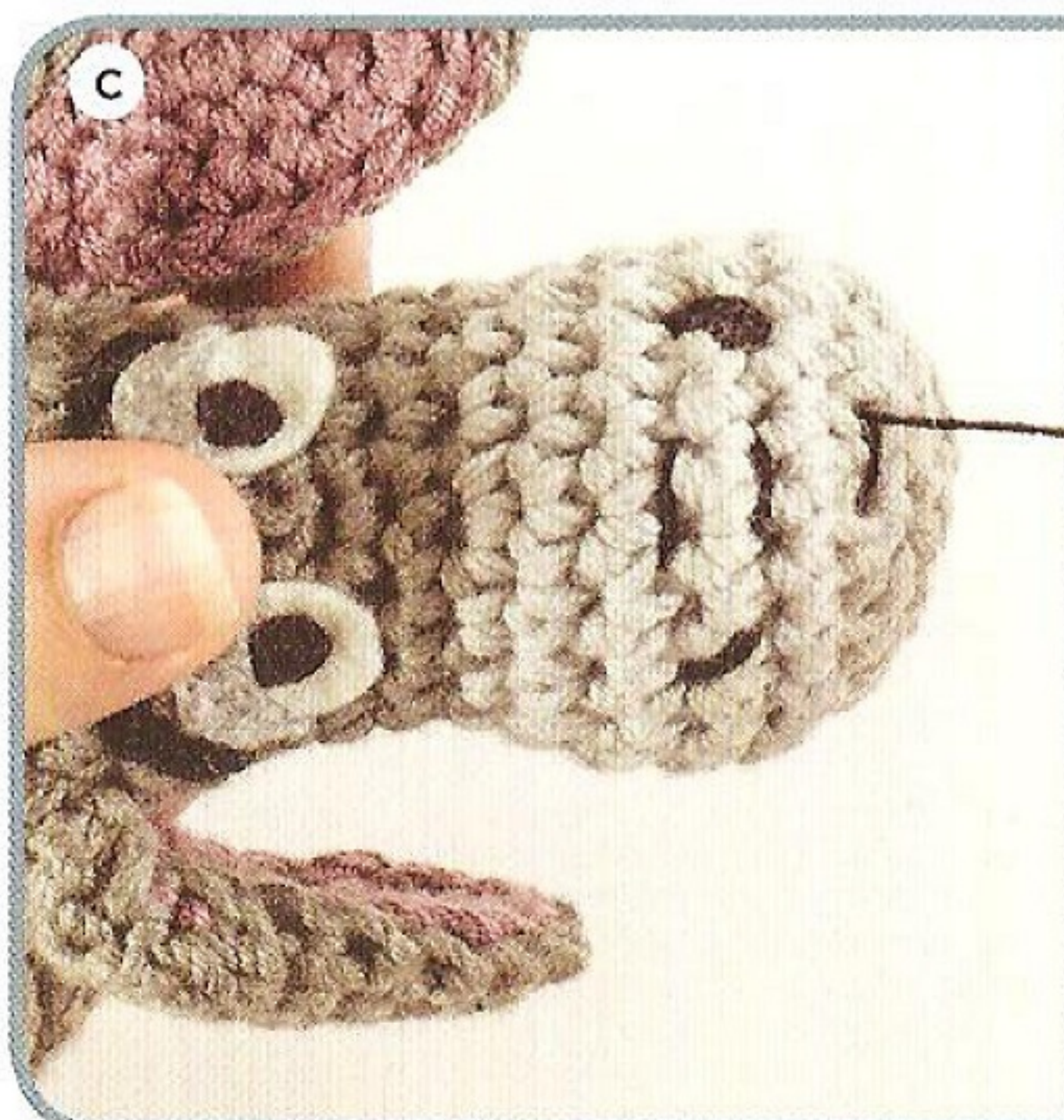
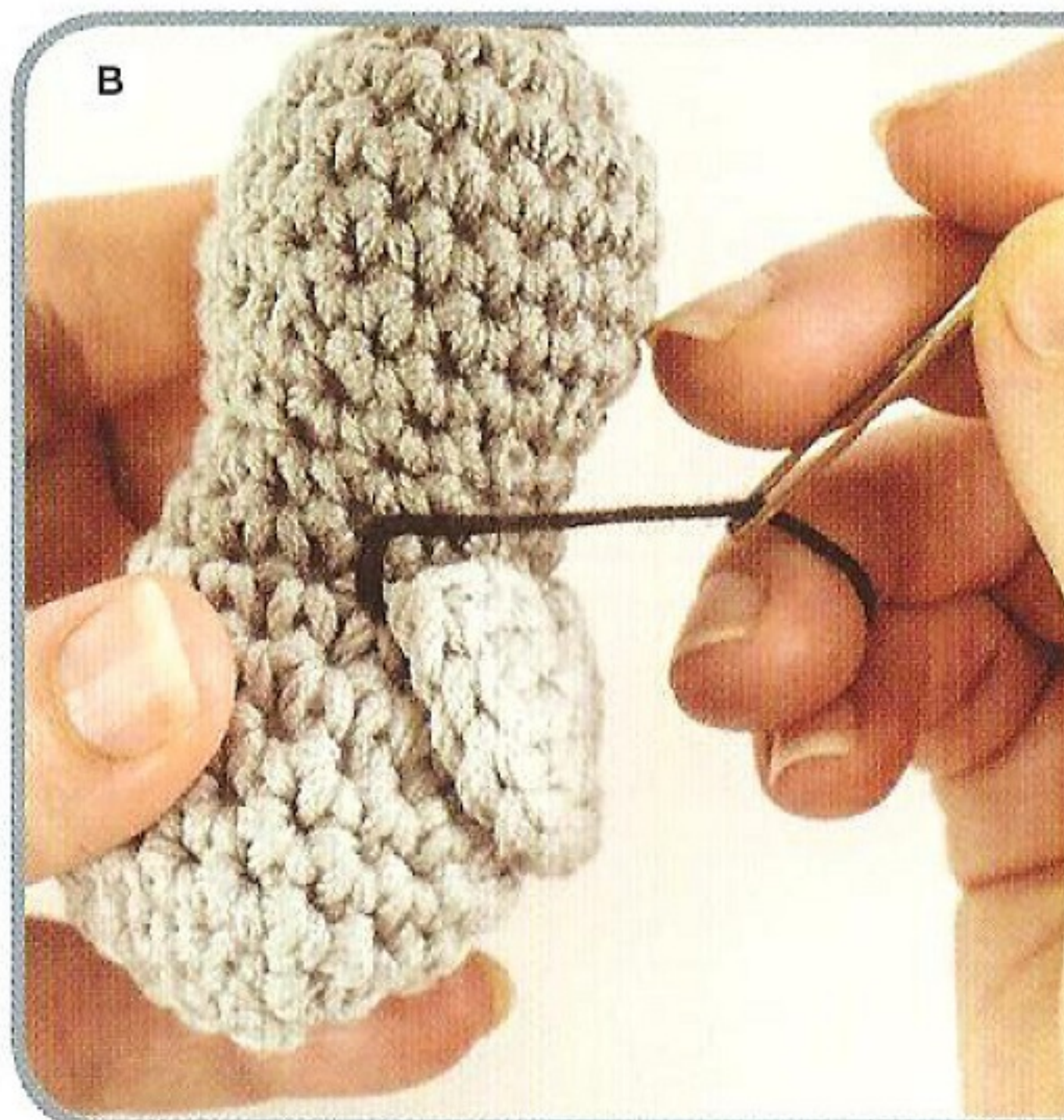
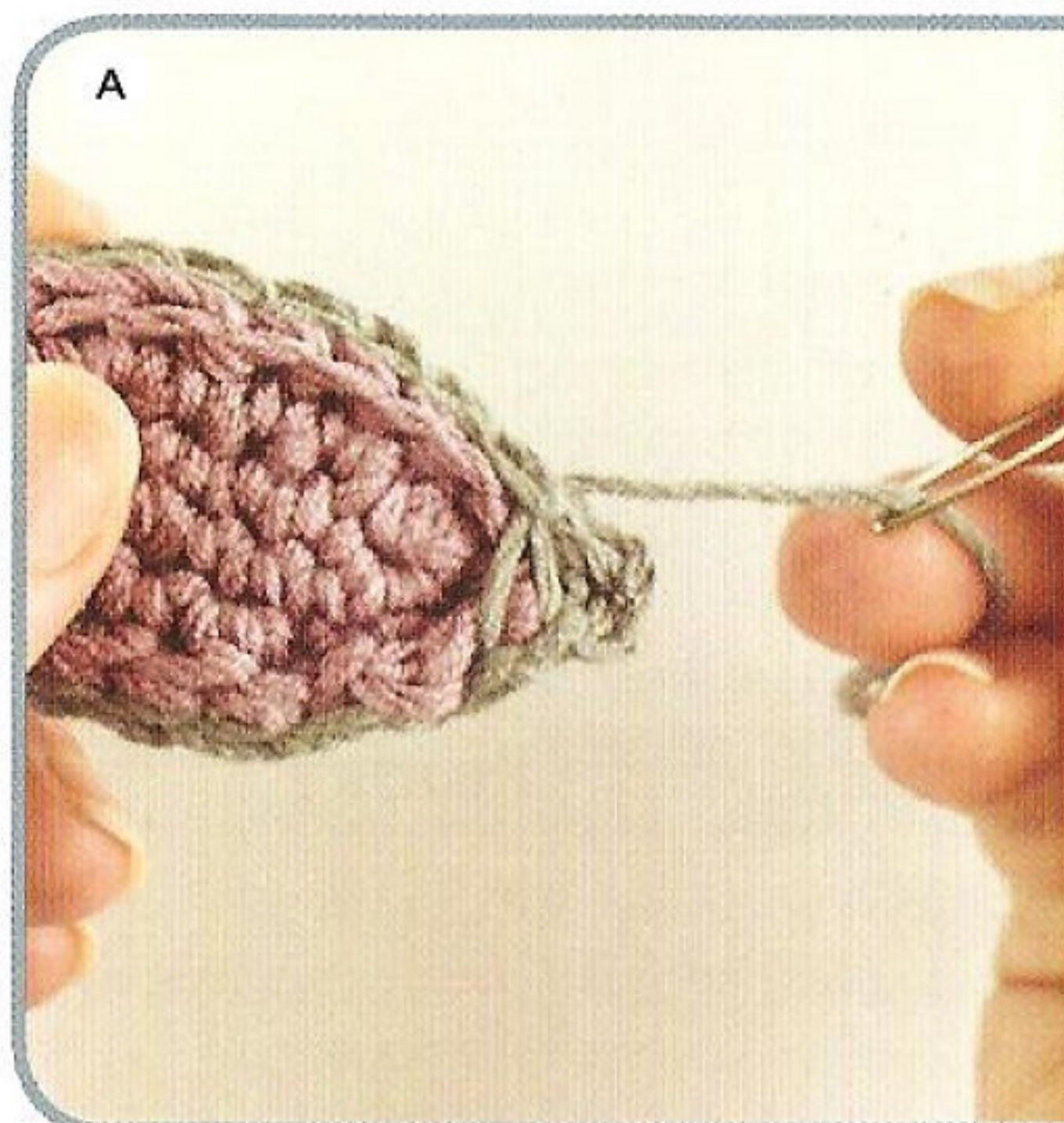
Rows 5-6: sk first ch, sc 4, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Row 7: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 2, ch 1 and turn. (3 sts)

Row 8: sk first ch, sc2tog, sl st 1, and fasten off.

LEFT BACK LEG

Row 1: with RS facing up, work along edge from row 20 pm toward row 14 pm. To rejoin light gray, (sl st 1, ch 1, sc 1) in



row 20 pm st, sc 6 to row 14 pm st, ch 1 and turn. Remove markers. (7 sts)

Row 2: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 5, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 3: sk first ch, sc 4, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (5 sts)

Row 4: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 3, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Rows 5-6: sk first ch, sc 4, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Row 7: sk first ch, sc 2, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (3 sts)

Row 8: sk first ch, sk 1, sc2tog. (1 st)
• Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

RIGHT BACK LEG

Row 1: with WS facing up, work along edge from row 20 pm toward row 14 pm. To rejoin light gray, (sl st 1, ch 1, sc 1) in row 20 pm st, sc 6 to row 14 pm st, ch 1 and turn. Remove markers. (7 sts)

Row 2: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 5, ch 1 and turn. (6 sts)

Row 3: sk first ch, sc 4, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (5 sts)

Row 4: sk first ch, sc2tog, sc 3, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Rows 5-6: sk first ch, sc 4, ch 1 and turn. (4 sts)

Row 7: sk first ch, sc 2, sc2tog, ch 1 and turn. (3 sts)

Row 8: sk first ch, sk 1, sc2tog. (1 st)
• Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

BOW TIE

• In magenta, loosely ch 12 and join last ch to first ch with a sl st to form a ring.

Rnds 1-4: sc 12. (12 sts)

• Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

TAIL

• In dark gray, loosely ch 10.

Row 1: starting in second ch from hook, sc 2 in next st, sc 8. (10 sts)

• Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Assembly

1. Place WS of lavender inner ear against RS of dark gray outer ear. Using a tapestry needle and lavender yarn, sew inner ear to inside surface of outer ear. Pinch tapered end of ear together and secure shaping with dark gray yarn (Fig. A).
2. Attach lower lip at back of light gray muzzle. Secure lower lip to bottom of muzzle with a few running stitches. Using black, draw a long stitch along crease where lower lip meets muzzle and add two short stitches at corners of mouth (Fig. B).
3. Cut out two eyes from white felt, two pupils from black felt, and two eyelids from medium gray felt using the templates on page 74. Assemble and glue or sew eyes and eyelids together before gluing or sewing eyes to head. Using black, sew eyebrows above eyes and nostrils to front of muzzle. Attach ears to sides of head. Separate out one or two strands of black yarn ply and apply three short stitches to front of muzzle (Fig. C).
4. With RS of belly piece facing down and the 3 rows of dark gray positioned at the front of the body, take one side piece and match up legs and lower halves of the chest

and hindquarters edges to one side of belly and secure with marking pins. Using dark gray, start at neck and whip stitch edges of chest, front leg, belly, back leg, and lower half of hindquarters together. Tie off and repeat on other side. Close back and hindquarters seams while leaving an opening in front for neck. Stuff body through neck hole. To keep legs from splaying out, attach light gray yarn to inside surface of one leg, pass yarn through body to inside surface of opposite leg, then back again through body to starting point. Pull gently to draw legs close to body (Fig. D).

5. Flatten bow tie piece and wrap tail tightly around its center to form the two sides of bow tie (Fig. E).
6. Cut three or four 4 in. pieces of black yarn and secure to bottom of tail using fringe technique. Separate yarn plies with a tapestry needle and trim. Attach bow tie to bottom of tail. Sew one half of a snap to top of tail. Cut out one nail head from grayish-blue felt using the templates on page 74, and attach it to the tail. Sew other half of snap to top of hindquarters (Fig. F).
7. Sew head to open edge of neck. Cut twelve to fifteen 4 in. pieces of black yarn and attach to top of head and in a line down neck to shoulders using the fringe technique. Separate yarn strands with tapestry needle and trim (Fig. G).
8. Weave in any remaining yarn tails.

FINISHED SIZE: About 9" tall.

Instructions

HEAD TOP

- In yellow, sc 8 in an adjustable ring.
- Rnd 1:** sc 2 in each st around. (16 sts)
- Rnds 2–4:** sc 16.
- Rnd 5:** *sc 1, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 7 more times. (24 sts)
- Rnd 6:** *sc 2, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 7 more times. (32 sts)
- Rnds 7–8:** sc 8, hdc 8, sl st 8, hdc 8. (32 sts)
- Rnd 9:** sc 8, sc2tog 4 times, sl st 4, pm, sl st 4, sc2tog 4 times. (24 sts)
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

HEAD BOTTOM

- In white, sc 8 in an adjustable ring.
- Rnd 1:** sc 2 in each st around. (16 sts)
- Rnd 2:** *sc 3, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 3 more times. (20 sts)
- Rnd 3:** *sc 1, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 9 more times. (30 sts)
- Rnd 4:** *sc 4, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 5 more times. (36 sts)
- Rnd 5:** sc 36.
- Rnd 6:** *sc 4, sc2tog; rep from * 5 more times. (30 sts)
- Rnd 7:** *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 9 more times. (20 sts)
- Rnd 8:** *sc 3, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (16 sts)
- Stuff.
- Rnd 9:** sc2tog 8 times. (8 sts)
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

NOSE

- In pink, sc 4 in an adjustable ring.
- Rnd 1:** sc 2 in each st around. (8 sts)
- Rnd 2:** sc 8.

- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

MUZZLE

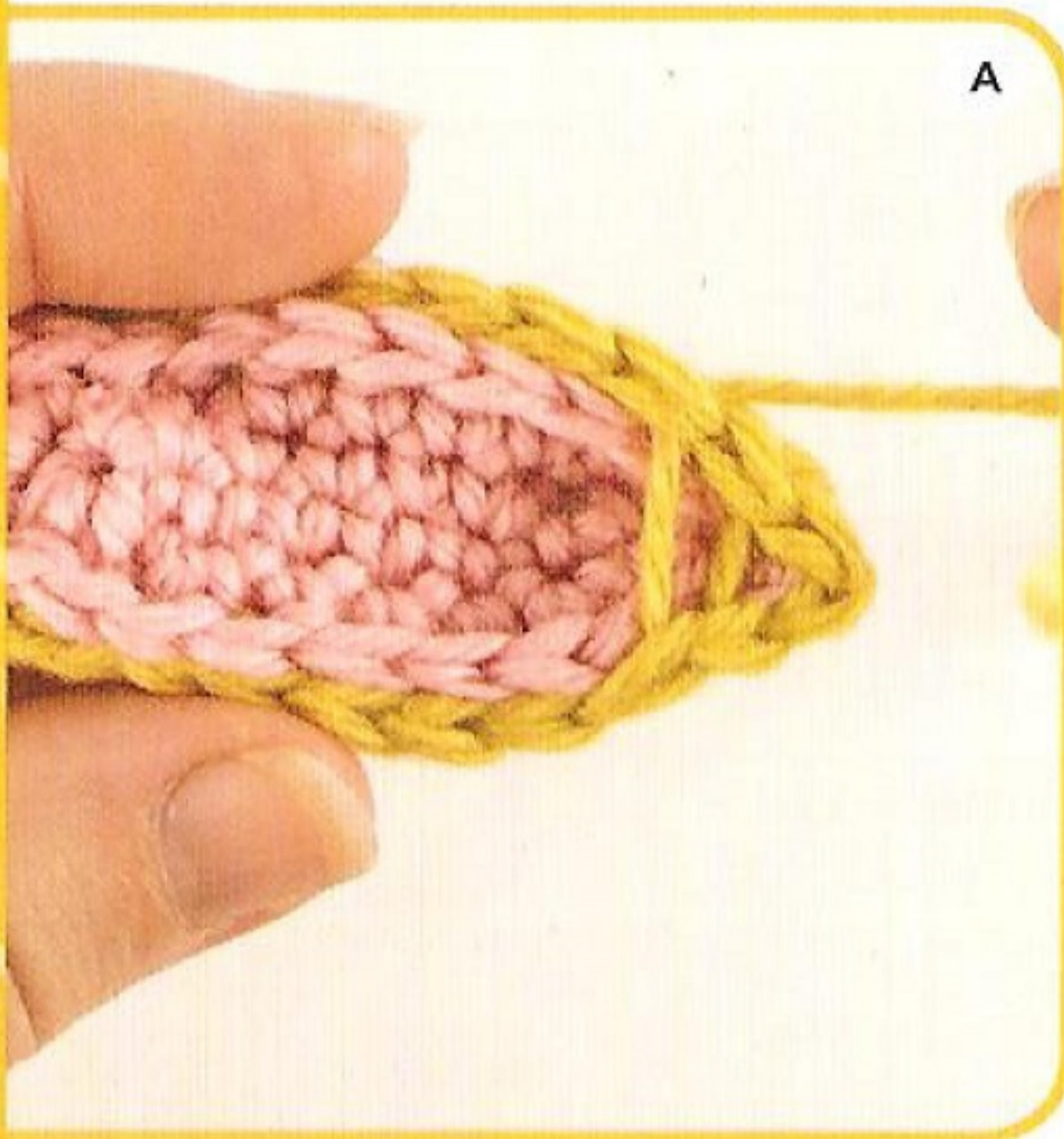
- In white, sc 6 in an adjustable ring.
- Rnd 1:** sc 2 in each st around. (12 sts)
- Rnds 2–3:** sc 12.
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

LOWER LIP

- In white, sc 8 in an adjustable ring.
- Rnd 1:** sc 8.
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Fold in half and sew edges together.

BODY

- In yellow, sc 10 in an adjustable ring.
- Rnd 1:** sc 2 in each st around. (20 sts)
- Rnd 2:** sc 20.
- Rnd 3:** *sc 1, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 9 more times. (30 sts)
- Rnds 4–7:** sc 30.
- Rnd 8:** *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 9 more times. (20 sts)
- Rnds 9–10:** sc 20.
- Rnd 11:** *sc 3, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (16 sts)
- Rnd 12:** sc 16.
- Rnd 13:** *sc 1, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 7 more times. (24 sts)
- Rnd 14:** sc 24.
- Rnd 15:** *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 7 more times. (16 sts)
- Rnd 16:** sc 16.
- Rnd 17:** *sc 2, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (12 sts)
- Rnd 18:** *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (8 sts)
- Stuff body.
- Rnd 19:** sc 8.
- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

LEGS (MAKE TWO)

- In yellow, sc 6 in an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: sc 2 in each st around. (12 sts)

Rnd 2: *sc 1, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 5 more times. (18 sts)

Rnds 3-4: sc 18.

Rnd 5: *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 5 more times. (12 sts)

Rnd 6: sc 12.

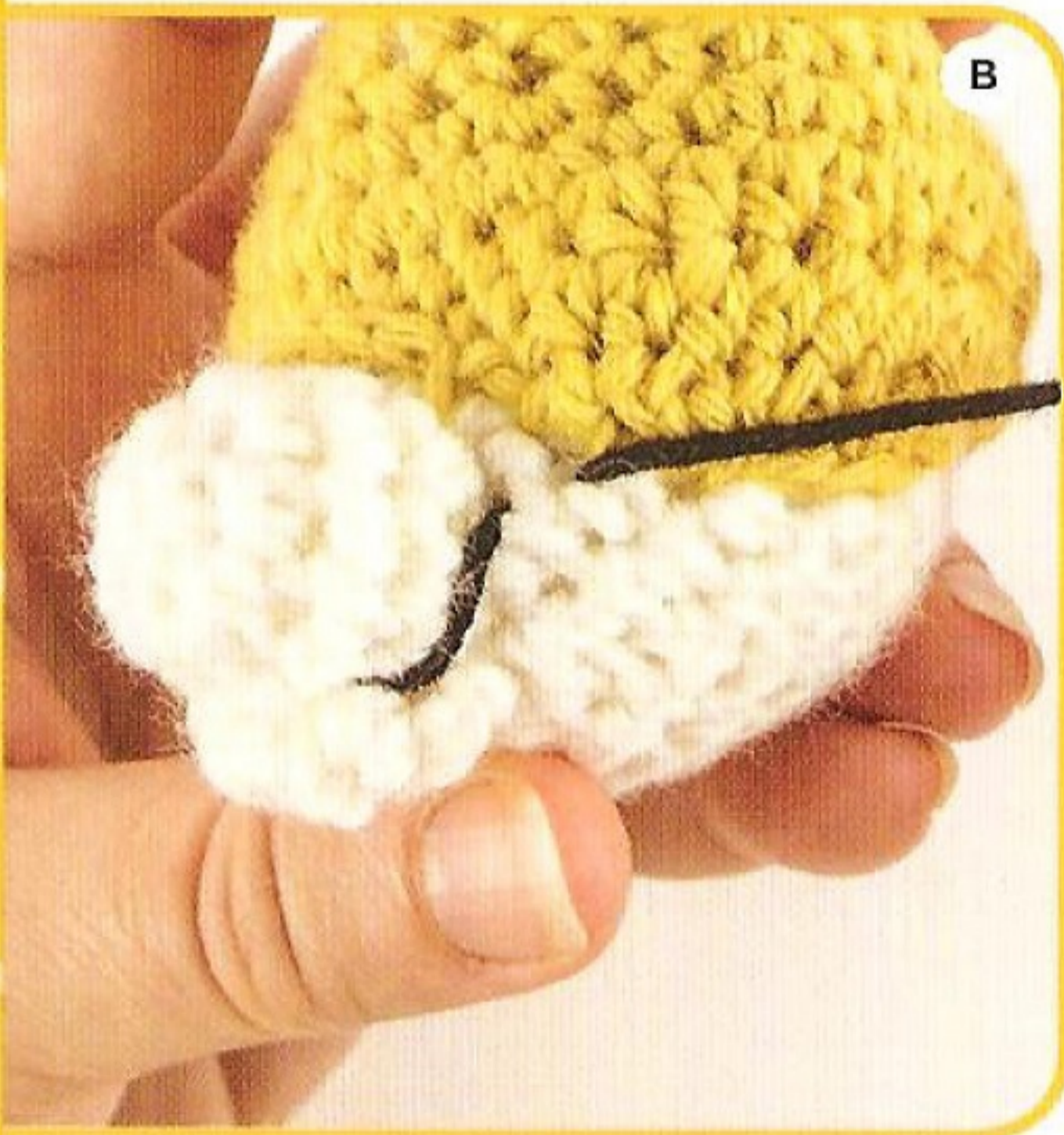
- Stuff leg.

Rnd 7: *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (8 sts)

Rnds 8-9: sc 4, hdc 4. (8 sts)

- Stuff ankle.

- Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

FEET (MAKE TWO)

- In yellow, sc 4 in an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: sc 2 in each st around. (8 sts)

Rnd 2: *sc 1, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 3 more times. (12 sts)

Rnd 3: *sc 2, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 3 more times. (16 sts)

Rnd 4: *sc 2, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (12 sts)

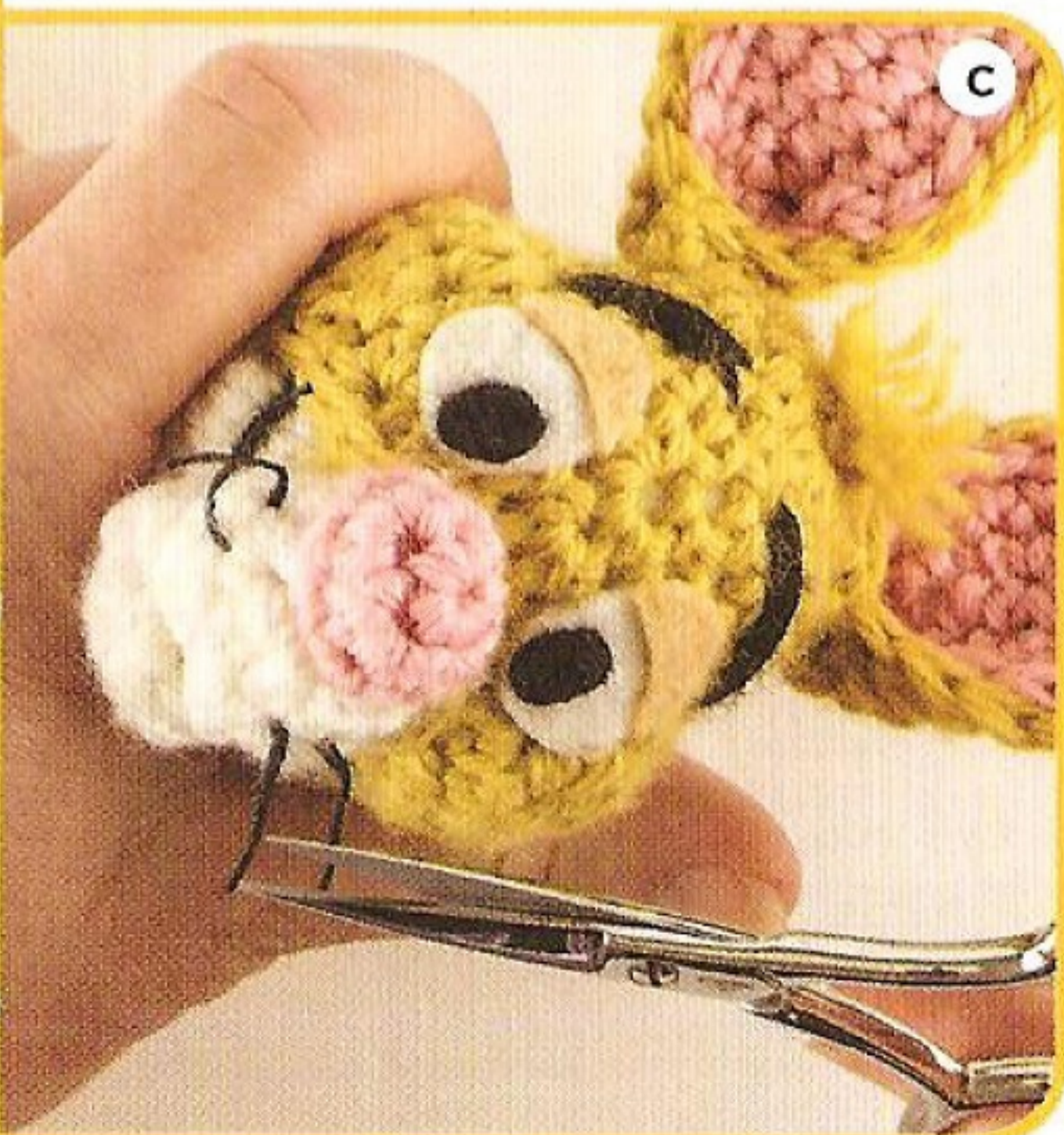
Rnds 5-8: sc 12.

- Stuff foot.

Rnd 9: *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (8 sts)

Rnd 10: *sc 2, sc2tog; rep from * 1 more time. (6 sts)

- Fasten off and close hole in back of foot.



C

HANDS AND ARMS (MAKE TWO)

- In yellow, sc 6 in an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: sc 2 in each st around. (12 sts)

Rnds 2-3: sc 12.

Rnd 4: *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (8 sts)

- Stuff hand.

Rnd 5: *sc 2, sc2tog; rep from * 1 more time. (6 sts)

Rnd 6: *sc 2, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 1 more time. (8 sts)

Rnds 7–9: sc 8.

• Stuff arm.

Rnd 10: *sc 2, sc2tog; rep from * 1 more time. (6 sts)

• Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Flatten seam and sew closed.

OUTER EARS (MAKE TWO)

• In yellow, loosely ch 8.

Rnd 1: starting in second ch from hook and working in back ridge loops, sc 6, sc 3 in next st. Rotate chain so front loops are facing up. Starting in next st and working in front loops, sc 5, sc 2 in next st. (16 sts)

Rnd 2: sl st 2, sc 4, sc 2 in next st, hdc 2 in next st, sc 2 in next st, sc 4, sl st 2, (hdc 1, dc 1, hdc 1) in next st. (21 sts)

Rnd 3: sl st 2, sc 6, hdc 2, sc 6, sl st 3, (sc 1, hdc 1, sc 1) in next st, sl st 1. (23 sts)

• Fasten off and weave in ends.

INNER EARS (MAKE TWO)

• In pink, loosely ch 8.

Rnd 1: starting in second ch from hook and working in back ridge loops, sc 6, sc 3 in next st. Rotate chain so front loops are facing up. Starting in next st and working in front loops, sc 5, sc 2 in next st. (16 sts)

Rnd 2: sl st 2, sc 4, sc 2 in next st, hdc 2 in next st, sc 2 in next st, sc 4, sl st 2, (hdc 1, dc 1, hdc 1) in next st. (21 sts)

• Fasten off and weave in ends.

BELLY

• In white, loosely ch 14.

Rnd 1: starting in second ch from hook and working in back ridge loops, sc 12, sc 3 in next st. Rotate chain so front loops are facing up. Starting in next st and working in front loops, sc 11, sc 2 in next st. (28 sts)

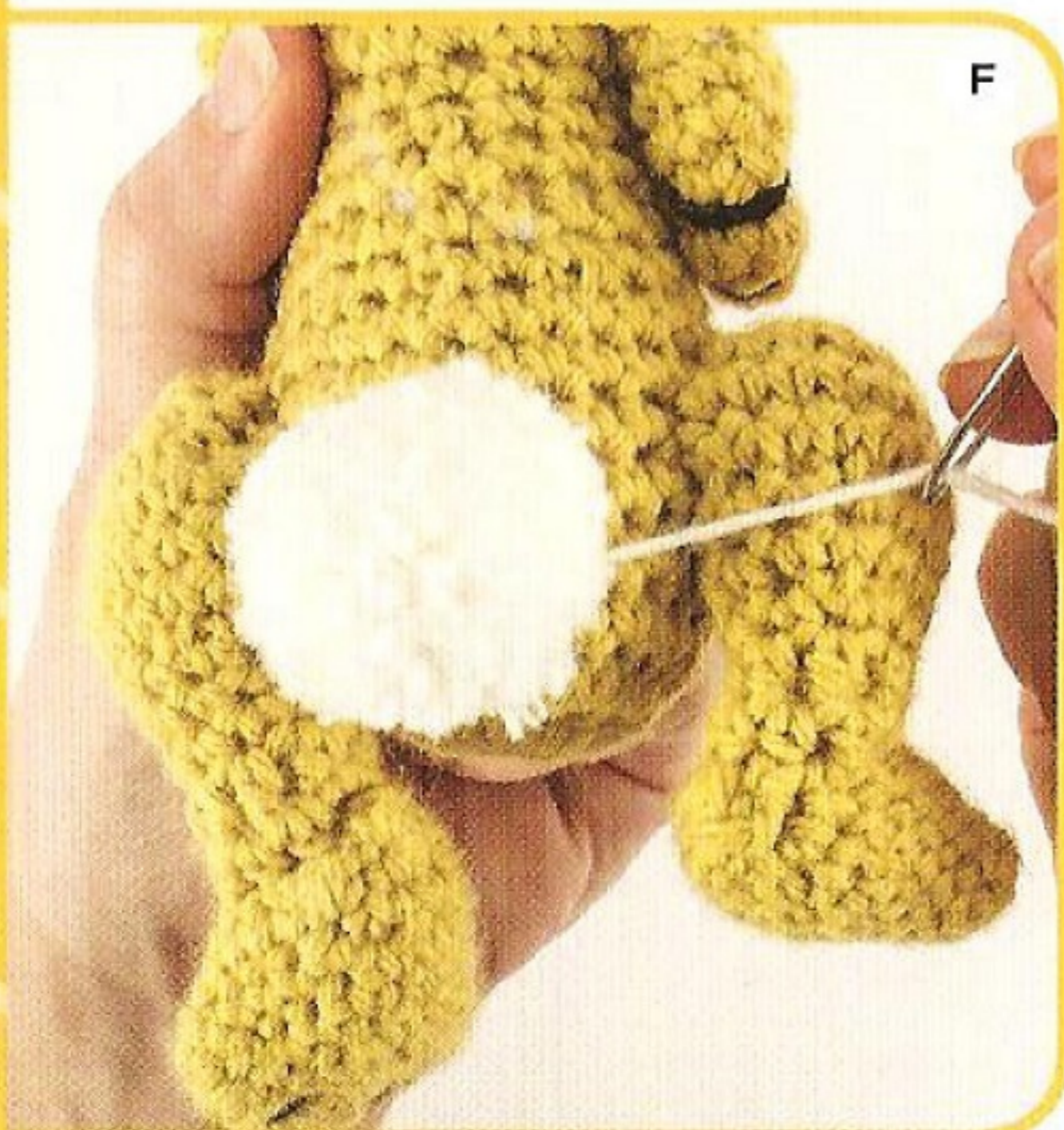
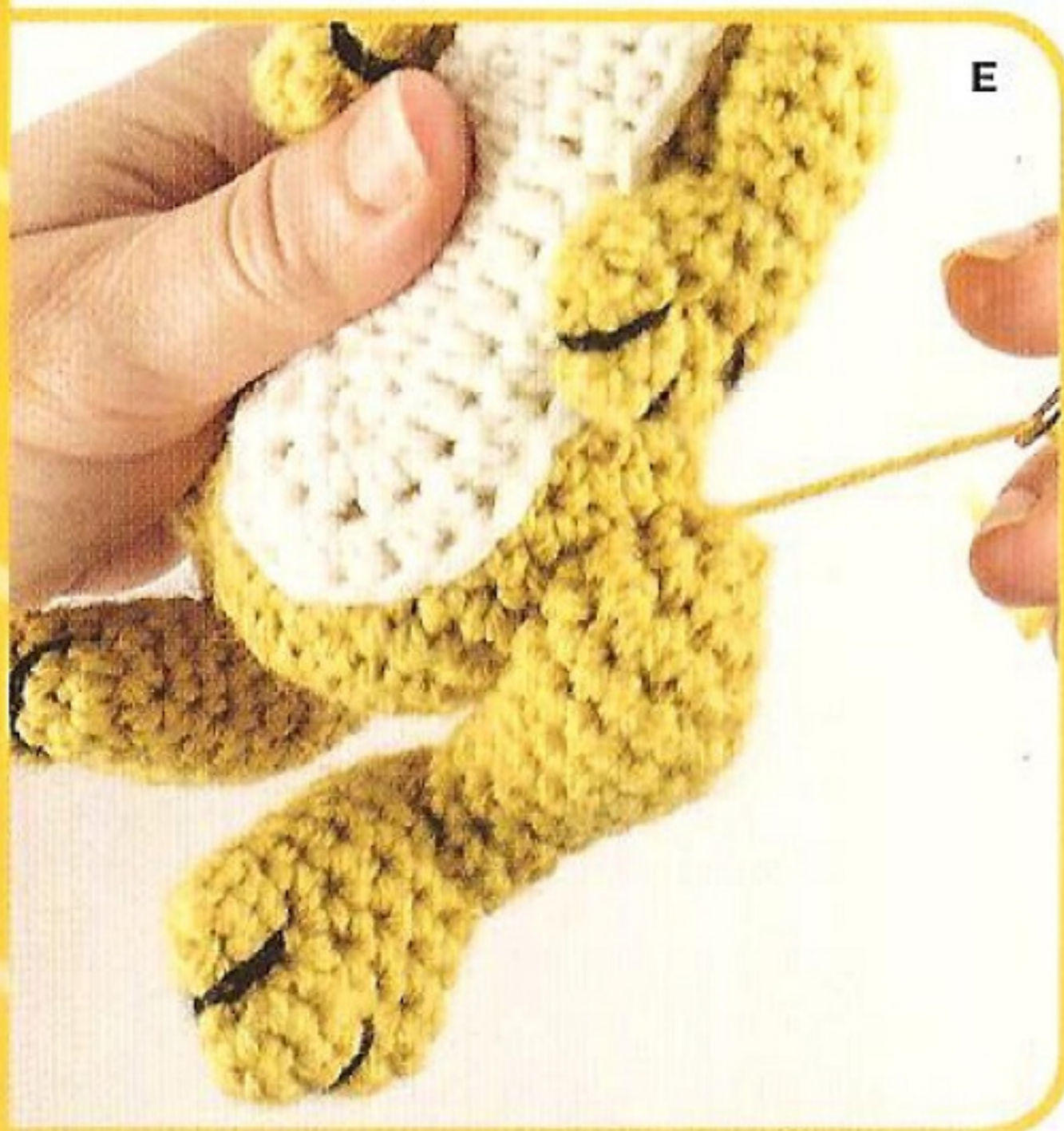
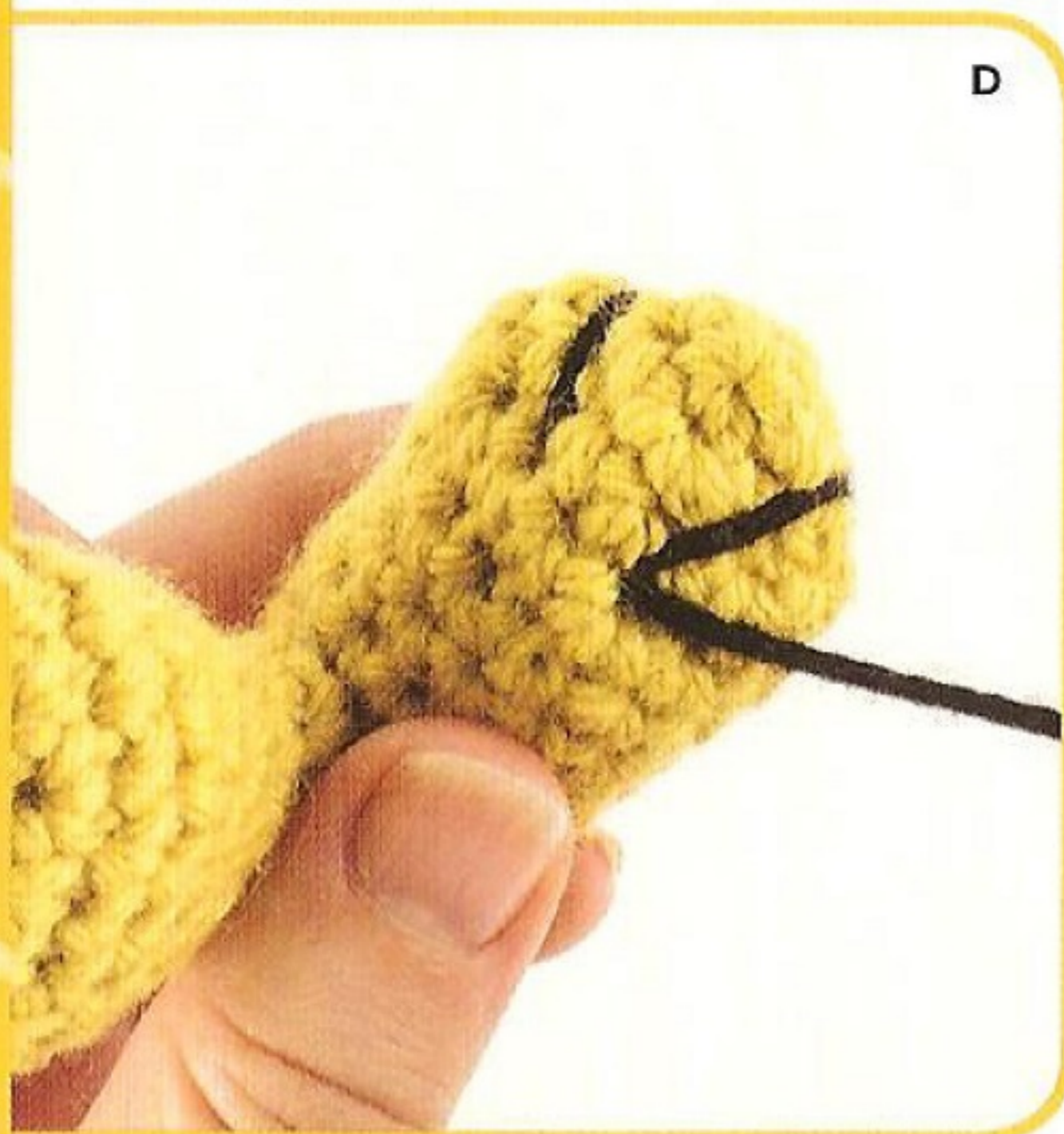
Rnd 2: sl st 2, sc 4, hdc 6, hdc 2 in next 3 sts, hdc 6, sc 4, sl st 2, sc 3 in next st. (33 sts)

Rnd 3: sl st 3, sc 4, hdc 5, hdc 2 in next 6 sts, hdc 5, sc 4, sl st 4, 3 sc in next st, sl st 1. (39 sts)

• Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Assembly

1. Place WS of pink inner ear against RS of yellow outer ear. Using a tapestry needle and pink yarn, sew inner ear to inside surface of outer ear. Pinch sides of rounder end of ear together and secure shaping with yellow yarn (Fig. A).
2. Sew open edge of muzzle to top half of head bottom and stuff before closing seam. Insert bottom of head into open end of head top, aligning muzzle below marker. Sew edge of head top down and stuff before closing seam. Sew closed edge of bottom lip to head bottom below muzzle. Using white, sew through bottom of lip into muzzle and back again two to three times to hold lower lip against muzzle. In black, run a long stitch along crease of mouth where muzzle and chin come together from one corner to other. Place a short stitch in each corner of mouth (Fig. B).
3. Attach nose to front of muzzle. Cut out two eyes from white felt, two eye pupils from black felt, and two eyelids from yellow felt using the templates on page 74. Glue or sew



eyes and eyelids together before attaching to face. Sew ears to top of head. Cut two 4 in. pieces of yellow yarn and attach between ears using fringe technique. Separate yarn plys with tapestry needle and trim. With black, sew a pair of stitches above each eye for eyebrows. For whiskers, draw leftover yarn from eyebrows out at bottom of head and separate yarn plys into individual pieces (if there are more than four plys, tuck extra plys back in). Threading one ply at a time onto needle, draw plys through front of muzzle to make four whiskers and trim to about an inch long. To help keep whiskers from getting fuzzy, take a drop of fabric glue and rub into plys to make them stiff. Once dry, trim whiskers to desired length (Fig. C).

4. Sew open edge of ankle to back of foot. With black, draw two or three long stitches onto front of feet in two locations, pulling tightly to shape toes (Fig. D).
5. Sew belly to front of body so top of neck lines up with opening at top of body. Sew head to top of neck. Sew arms to body at shoulders. With black, draw two or three long stitches onto front of hands in three locations, pulling tightly to shape paws. Sew legs to body at hips (Fig. E).
6. Wind white yarn around three or four fingers thirty to forty times. Tie this bundle of loops together in middle and cut through loops on both ends. Trim pom-pom down to about 1 in. diameter and attach to back of body for a tail (Fig. F).

STUFFING

MARKING PINS

SCISSORS

Optional: ROW COUNTER, SPLIT/LOCKING RINGS

FINISHED SIZE: About 8" tall.

Instructions

HEAD

• In orange, sc 8 in an adjustable ring.

• Stuff head.

Rnd 9: sc 2, sc 2 in next st, change to beige, sc 2, sc 2 in next 2 sts, sc 2, change to orange, sc 2 in next st, sc 2. (16 sts)

Rnd 10: sc 2, change to beige, sc 2, hdc 8, sc 2, change to orange, sc 2. (16 sts)

• Change to beige.

Rnd 11: *sc 7, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 1 more time. (18 sts)

Rnd 12: *sc 5, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 2 more times. (21 sts)

Rnd 13: *sc 6, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 2 more times. (24 sts)

Rnd 14: *sc 5, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 3 more times. (28 sts)

Rnd 15: *sc 5, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (24 sts)

Rnd 16: sc2tog 12 times. (12 sts)

• Stuff muzzle lightly.

Rnd 17: sc2tog 6 times. (6 sts)

• Fasten off, close up hole, and weave in tail.

• In dark pink, sc 4 in an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: sc 2 in each st around. (8 sts)

Rnd 2: sc 8. (8 sts)

Rnds 4-5: sc 18.

Rnd 6: *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 5 more times. (12 sts)

Rnds 7-8: sc 12.

Rnd 9: *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (8 sts)

Rnd 10: sc 8.

Rnd 11: sc 2, hdc 2 in next 4 sts, sc 2. (12 sts)

Rnd 12: sc 2, sc2tog, hdc 2 in next 4 sts, sc2tog, sc 2. (14 sts)

Rnd 13: sc 4, sc2tog, hdc 2, sc2tog, sc 4. (12 sts)

- Stuff. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Flatten seam along length of foot and sew closed.

Rnd 10: *sc 2, sc 2 in next st; rep from * 2 more times. (12 sts)

Rnd 11: sc 12.

- Stuff arm.

Rnd 12: *sc 1, sc2tog; rep from * 3 more times. (8 sts)

- Stuff. Flatten seam and sew closed, leaving a long tail for attachment.

Assembly

1. Place WS of beige inner ear against RS of orange outer ear. Using a tapestry needle and beige yarn, sew inner ear to inside surface of outer ear. Pinch bottom end of ear together and secure shaping with orange yarn (Fig. A).
2. Sew nose and flap behind nose to front and top of muzzle. The grouping of orange stitches on rnds 9 and 10 of head will be facing up. Using black, draw a long stitch tightly across front of beige portion of muzzle (just above center) to form mouth. Apply two short





stitches to corners of mouth. Draw one more long stitch from center of mouth to bottom of nose to form lip cleft. For whiskers, draw leftover yarn from mouth out at bottom of head and separate yarn plys into individual pieces (if there are more than four plys, tuck extra plys back in). Threading one ply at a time onto your needle, draw plys through front of muzzle to make four whiskers and trim to about an inch long. To help keep whiskers from getting fuzzy, take a drop of fabric glue and rub into plys to make them stiff. Once dry, trim whiskers to desired length (Fig. B).

3. Cut out two pupils and one eyebrow from black felt and one eye patch out of beige felt using template (p. 75). Glue or sew pupils to eye shape. Glue or sew eyes to head above muzzle. Glue or sew eyebrow above eye shape. Separate out one black yarn ply and apply a curved short stitch and an overcast stitch above eyes. Sew ears to top of head. For head stripes, cut out two large, one medium, one small, four mini, and four extra-small stripes from black felt using the templates. Starting from top of head and working down, apply two large stripes, one medium stripe, and one small stripe. Apply a pair of mini stripes to each side of nose bridge and two extra-small stripes to each cheek behind corners of mouth (Fig. C).
4. Using orange, shape tail by applying a small line of running stitches to top of tail between center of tail

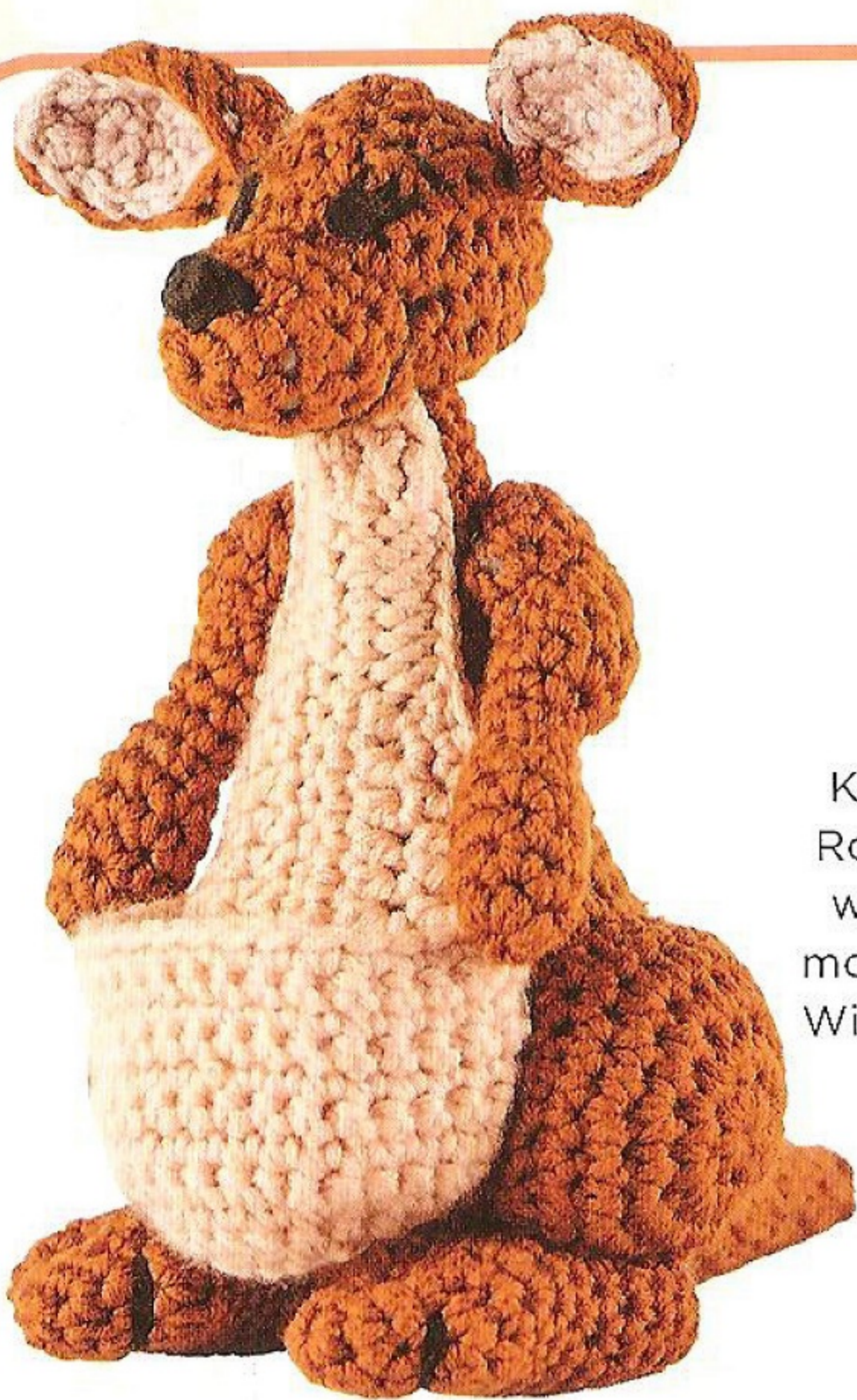
and the open edge and to the bottom of tail between center of tail and black tip. Pull tightly to make tail kink in two spots (Fig. D).

5. Sew belly to front of body. Attach arms at shoulders and legs at hips. Sew thumbs to hands. Attach open edge of tail to back of body (Fig. E).

6. Sew head to body. For body stripes, cut out four large, thirteen medium, and twelve small stripes from black felt using the templates on page 75. Apply one medium stripe to back of neck. Starting from shoulders and working toward tail, apply one medium and two large stripes. Apply one small and one medium stripe to each side of body (overlapping belly slightly). For each arm, starting with a medium stripe at shoulder, apply two medium and two small stripes. For each leg, starting with a medium stripe at hip, apply two medium and two small stripes. For tail, apply two large stripes, one medium stripe, and two small stripes (Fig. F).

7. Weave in any remaining yarn tails.

Assembly

1. Sew open edge of muzzle to front of head at marker between cheeks and stuff before closing seam (remove marker). Using black, draw a long stitch below muzzle for a mouth. Using black, apply a French knot to front of muzzle. Wind black yarn around base of French knot three or four times and then draw needle through top of knot to secure wrap (Fig. A).
2. Cut out two eyes from black felt using the templates on page 74. Sew or glue to head above muzzle. Sew two stitches above eyes for eyebrows. Attach ears. Cut one 4 in. piece of brown yarn and attach to

top of head using fringe technique. Separate yarn plies with a tapestry needle and trim (Fig. B).

3. Attach arms at shoulders. Attach open edge of legs to sides of belly and attach feet underneath legs (Fig. C).
4. Attach tail to back of body (Fig. D).
5. Weave in any remaining yarn tails.
